
Head Brewer/Manager

- Not "Homebrew done bigger"
- Pub brewer can be pretty close
- Making same recipes over and over
- Lots of cleaning, safety, paperwork
- Packaging is a Pain (Guess where new employees start!)

What Does Brewer Make?

- Assistant Brewer: \$18,000 \$32,000
 - Same for entry level at production brewery
- Head Brewer: \$40,000 \$75,000
 - About the same for sales/marketing

If you want to switch careers

Working for a Brewery

- Hours: long/erratic/weekends
- Pay is not great
- There are rules:
 - Business conduct
 - DUIs, public behavior
- No matter what your title: you represent the brand

Doing Your Own Business

- Expand Your Existing Business in to Beer/Brewing
- New Entity following Existing Beer Business Model
 - Bar, restaurant
 - Distributor
 - Supplier
- Apply Business Model from Another Business to Beer
 - Keg Rental
 - Beer Tours
 - Untapped
 - DIY Kits

Doing Your Own Business

- Equipment / supply sales
- Line Cleaning
- Events, tours, classes

A Word of Caution

- Shipping Beer
 - Not Easy
 - May be Impossible!
